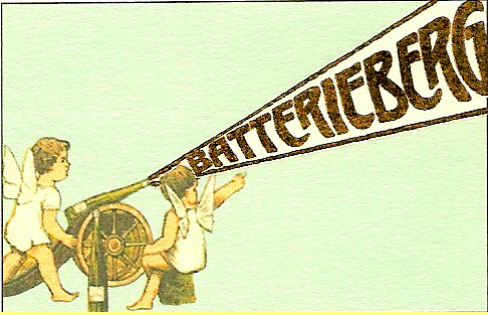
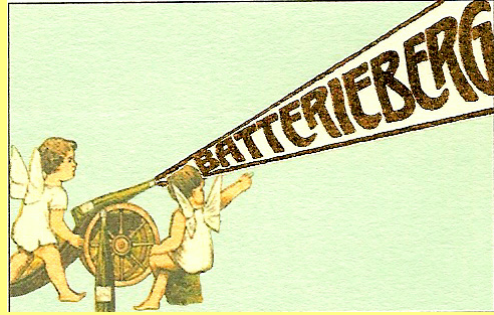


An Explosion of Flavor! **2008 Detonation Riesling**



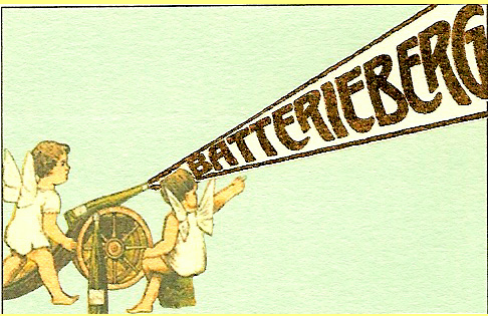
In the 19th century, the Enkircher Batterieberg vineyard was one of the first vineyards in the world to be artificially formed by blasting the hillside with dynamite. It took five years and a lot of dynamite to make enough of a slope to plant vines. Detonation Riesling pays homage to the vineyard created with dynamite. This off-dry, very modern Riesling combines flavors of citrus, apple, pear and stony minerality. The grapes are sourced from steep sloped vineyards in the Mosel river valley.

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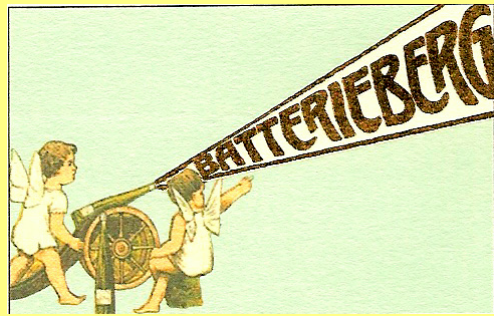
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
